## Brackenhurst Walks

You are now entering the Brackenhurst estate, an area of 200-hectares of mixed farmland owned and managed by Nottingham Trent University.

The site is used to educate over 1,000 students each year in agricultural, environmental, animal and rural sciences. Our “open air classroom” is an invaluable tool in shaping our graduates; the real-life experience we can bring to their studies is what makes this site so special.

In addition to a working farm with 200 sheep and cattle plus a variety of crops on rotation, the site contains numerous features that are important in terms of landscape, heritage and wildlife. These include ancient trackways, woodland, the Dumbles, ponds and hedgerows.

Brackenhurst Walks has been designed to guide visitors around the estate discovering these special places. You are free to choose your own route but if you do wish to concentrate on certain species, or features, we have listed a number of suggested routes.

Walks are of various lengths but strong sturdy footwear is advised for all. Also we would appreciate it if you could follow the stipulated routes and ensure that dogs are kept on a lead whilst you are on the estate.

## Countryside Code

Please respect the estate and its wildlife by following these simple rules:

- keep to the footpaths and bridleways provided;
- leave gates and property as you find them;
- keep dogs under close control at all times especially around livestock;
- do not pick wild flowers;
- take your litter home.
